City of Corner Brook Business Improvement Program 2011

The City of Corner Brook Business Improvement deadline is extended to July 8th at 4:30 p.m. The program is offered to businesses located on Caribou

Road (up to # 26), Broadway, West Street, Main Street, Herald Avenue, Church Street, Park Street, Commercial Street, Brook Street, Marsh Street, Lester Avenue as well as Maple Valley Road. The program provides property or business owners a tax credit for work done to improve the front façade of their building. The tax credit is 50% of project value, up to \$10,000 tax credit for a façade renovation that is worth \$20,000 or more. Applications will be approved based on good design and overall improvement to the building. Applicants are strongly encouraged to incorporate heritage components into their design.
